Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update

Dear Resident / Representative:

This letter is to provide an update on the status of the Veterans Home's efforts to prevent the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19). The safety and wellbeing of all residents is our top priority. The Infection Prevention and Control Committee continues to meet as necessary to review and act on guidance from the federal and state government, and work closely with health department contacts.

A total of twenty-one residents have tested positive since testing started along with one resident who was presumed to be positive. We are currently conducting facility-wide resident tests every 3-7 days until there are 14 consecutive days of no positive employee or resident tests. Residents are also tested if they are symptomatic and when required prior to a hospital procedure or medical appointment.

Twenty-six employees have tested positive or presumptive positive since testing became readily available. Staff are being tested at least every 7 days, similar to residents.

The Apple Neighborhood is on a higher level of precautions due to the potential contact with an employee who tested positive. These precautionary measures include requiring residents to remain in their rooms with their door closed whenever possible. Based on current positive tests, the next possible start date for outside visitations for everyone will be October 14th.

Video chatting continues to be available. Please speak with Recreation Therapy (RT) staff about setting this up for you. RT staff also help with window visits and they need to be arranged at least 24 hours in advance of the visit.
