Dear Resident / Representative:

The Veterans Home continues efforts to prevent the spread and impact of the coronavirus. The safety and wellbeing of all residents is our top priority. The Infection Prevention and Control Committee meets regularly to respond to our current situation, review new guidance, and work closely with our health department contacts.

There has been no update from New York State about changes recently enacted by the federal government to our COVID-19 response. We will let you know as changes occur.

We had no residents or staff tested positive this past week. Pine Neighborhood is expected to come out of outbreak status at 12:01am on Sunday, May 21. Residents and staff continue to be tested for COVID-19 if they meet qualifying conditions. You will be notified of all positive results.

Please follow the visitation guide, available on our website or at Security, when visiting. Visitors should still consider postponing visits if COVID-19 positive, sick, or exposed to someone with COVID-19. Please pay attention to precaution signs when visiting and follow the directions. They will help protect you and others.
