The Veterans Home at Batavia is a participating member of the Western New York Mutual Aid Plan.

As community members, we collaborate with other agencies to ensure your loved one is well cared for during an emergency.

The Home has an Emergency Operation Plan in the case of an emergency or crisis. It allows government at various levels — such as federal, state, city, and local — to communicate effectively and coordinate efforts to respond to crises.

In the event of any emergency which requires the program to evacuate and relocate, each family will be notified as soon as possible via telephone.
