ORDER VACATING AN INTERIM ORDER OF CONDITIONS PURSUANT TO N.Y. PUB. HEALTH LAW § 230

TO: ROY MONSOUR, M.D.

On or about June 6, 2019, the New York State Board for Professional Medical Conduct issued an Interim Order of Conditions (BPMC Order No.19-140) precluding the Licensee from practicing medicine in New York State or in any setting or jurisdiction where that practice is predicated upon Dr. Monsour's New York State medical license.

Whereas the Director of the Office of Professional Medical Conduct has determined that no hearing is warranted following the conclusion of an investigation.

It is, therefore:

ORDERED, that effective immediately, the Interim Order of Conditions issued pursuant to N.Y. Pub. Health Law § 230 on June 6, 2019 (BPMC Order No. 19-140) for ROY MONSOUR M.D., shall be vacated, and Dr. Roy Monsour's license to practice medicine in the State of New York shall be fully restored with no restrictions or conditions.
