WHEREAS, on or about July 16, 2020, petitioner Doctor Lawrence Womack ("Petitioner"), filed the instant Article 78 proceeding seeking to annul a Determination and order by respondent Administrative Review Board for Professional Medical Conduct ("ARB"), to the extent it upheld a professional misconduct finding against Petitioner made pursuant to Education Law 6530(9)(c) ("Specification One"),

WHEREAS, Petitioner did not and does not appeal the ARB's Determination and Order to the extent it upheld a professional misconduct finding against Petitioner made pursuant to Education Law 6530(28) and imposed discipline consisting of a Censure and Reprimand and 10 hours of Continuing Medical Education ("Specification Two"),

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the undersigned parties, as follows:

1. Specification One against Petitioner based on Education Law 6530(9)(c) is withdrawn by respondent The New York State Department of Health. The ARB's Determination and Order, including the discipline it imposed as set forth above, is otherwise unaffected by this Stipulation.


2. Pursuant to Rule 1250.2(b) of the Practice Rules of the Appellate Division, the instant Article 78 Petition is hereby discontinued with prejudice and without costs, disbursements or fees to either party as against the other.

3. This Stipulation and any Order entered thereon shall have no precedential value or effect whatsoever and shall not be admissible in any other action or proceeding as evidence or for any other purpose, except in an action or proceeding to enforce this Stipulation.


4. For purposes of this stipulation, facsimile, scanned, or e-mail signatures shall have the same force and effect as originals, and this stipulation may be executed in counterparts.
