
Upon the application of LEONARD SOLOMON, M.D. (Respondent) for Consent Order, which application is made a part hereof, it is

proceeding; and such denial by the Board shall be made without prejudice to the continuance of any disciplinary proceeding and the final determination by the Board pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Law.

I agree that, in the event the Board grants my Application, as set forth herein, an order of the Chairperson of the Board shall be issued in accordance with same.

I am making this Application of my own free will and accord and not under duress, compulsion or restraint of any kind or manner.





SPECIFICATION

Respondent is charged with professional misconduct within the meaning of N.Y. Educ. Law Sec. 6530 (9) (a) (i) (McKinney Supp. 1994), in that Respondent was convicted of committing an act constituting an act under New York state law, specifically:

On or about April 14, 1986, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted of violating N.Y. Penal Law section 120.00, assault in the third degree, specifically, Respondent hit his wife, now ex-wife. Respondent received a sentence of \$1,000 and probation for a period of three years.
