for Professional Medical Conduct, nothing contained herein shall be binding upon me or construed to be an admission of any act of misconduct alleged or charged against me, such application shall not be used against me in any way, and shall be kept in strict confidence during the pendency of the professional misconduct disciplinary proceeding; and such denial by the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct shall be made without prejudice to the continuance of any disciplinary proceeding and the final determination by a Committee on Professional Medical Conduct pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Law.

I agree that in the event the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct grants my application, an order shall be issued striking my name from the roster of physicians in the State of New York without further notice to me.

I am making this Application of my own free will and accord and not under duress, compulsion, or restraint of any kind or manner.

STATEMENT

OF

CHARGES

Harvey Bigelson, M.D., the Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State in or about 1966, by the issuance of license number 097755 by the New York State Education Department. The Respondent is not currently registered with the New York State Education Department to practice medicine. His current address is 710 Whiting Court, San Diego, CA 92109.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- A. On or about October 21, 1993, Respondent entered a guilty plea admitting 6 counts of a federal criminal indictment. The counts admitted, all felonies, included the filing of false or fraudulent claims, mail fraud, and conspiracy to obstruct justice. This plea was entered before the U.S. District Court for the District of Arizona.
- B. By an order of the Arizona Board of Medical Examiners of the State of Arizona, Respondent's license to practice medicine in that state was surrendered and cancelled, upon stipulation of the parties, based upon Respondent's entry of plea as set forth in Paragraph A, supra. This order was entered May 2, 1994.
