DIRECTOR'S FIRST
MODIFICATION
ORDER

Respondent, SETH FIELDING, M.D., is currently subject to BPMC Order # 18-038 (henceforth "Original Order"), which was issued upon a Consent Agreement issued on February 21, 2018. The Original Order imposed three years of Probation, including a Probation Term requiring a Clinical Competency Assessment. On or about May 21 and 22, 2018 Respondent underwent a Clinical Competency Assessment at the Albany Medical College, and a report of the evaluation was issued on July 24, 2018.

Paragraph 10 of the Terms of Probation provides that:

Respondent shall be subject to any further terms of probation as may be imposed by Director, in the Director's sole reasonable discretion, as the Director deems necessary based upon all relevant facts and circumstances then known to OPMC, including, but not limited to, those related to the OPMC investigation of Respondent, the results and recommendations of the CCA, the Preceptor's reports, and Respondent's practice in the future, as deemed by the Director to be necessary to protect the public health. Respondent, by making this Application, stipulates that the Director shall be so authorized.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Director of the Office of Professional Medical Conduct by the Original Order, it is hereby:

ORDERED, that Respondent shall undergo a [REDACTED]
examination to be performed on September 6, 2018, commencing at 10:00 A. M., by [REDACTED]

ORDERED, that Respondent must confirm with [REDACTED] his participation in the [REDACTED] evaluation by no later than August 16, 2018.

ORDERED, that no extension shall be granted unless the Director approves in writing an alternative date for the evaluation.

ORDERED, that Respondent must comply with Paragraph 9 of the Terms of Probation to identify a Preceptor within 60 days following the completion of the Clinical Competency Evaluation. (September 23, 2018).

ORDERED, that Respondent shall cooperate with the Preceptor to fulfill Recommendations 4, 5 and 6 in the Report of the Clinical Competency Assessment dated July 24, 2018.

ORDERED, that Respondent shall take and successfully complete no less than 30 CME credits annually in the areas of pharmacotherapy for ADHD, anxiety and depression as well as non-medication therapies for the same conditions.

ORDERED, that Respondent shall remain subject to all the Probation Terms and Conditions set forth in the Original Order, including that the Director of the Office of Professional Medical Conduct may continue to impose additional terms of Probation "as the Director deems necessary based upon all relevant facts".

ORDERED, that this Order shall be effective upon issuance and mailing by first class mail to Respondent at the address in the attached Consent Agreement or at any other address known to the Office of Professional Medical Conduct.
