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STATEMENT  
OF  
CHARGES

MAJD ARNAOUT, M.D., Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on July 15, 2009, by the issuance of license number 254063 by the New York State Education Department.

**FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS**

A. On or about November 21, 2016, in the Circuit Court for Howard County, State of Maryland, Respondent was found guilty, based on a jury verdict of guilty, of Assault in the Second Degree, a misdemeanor, in violation of Maryland Ann. Code CR §3-203, and was sentenced to six months of incarceration (suspended), one year of probation supervision with domestic violence education, court costs of \$145.00, and no adverse contact with his wife.

B. The conduct for which Respondent was convicted pursuant to Maryland Ann. Code CR §3-203, if committed in this state, would constitute a crime under New York State law, to wit, Assault in the Third Degree, a class A misdemeanor, in violation of New York State Penal Law §120.00.
