The undersigned, Howard A. Zucker, M.D., J.D., Commissioner of Health, pursuant to New York Public Health Law §230, upon consideration of the physician profile maintained by the Alaska State Medical Board which shows that a Consent Agreement dated November 3, 2017, effective January 2, 2018, terminated Respondent's suspension, previously ordered on March 3, 2017, and therefore showing that Respondent is no longer an imminent danger to the public health and safety, has therefore determined that there no longer exists good cause for continuance of the Commissioner's Summary Order issued on August 23, 2017, against CHRISTOPHER JENSEN, M.D., Respondent, New York, license number 248277, and

It is, therefore:

ORDERED, that effective Immediately, the Commissioner's Summary Order for CHRISTOPHER JENSEN, M.D., shall be rescinded, and Respondent's license to practice medicine in the State of New York shall be fully restored.
