The undersigned, Howard A. Zucker, M.D., J.D., Commissioner of Health, pursuant to N.Y. Public Health Law §230, upon the recommendation of a Committee on Professional Medical Conduct of the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct, has determined that the duly authorized professional disciplinary agency of another jurisdiction, the Alaska State Medical Board, has made a finding substantially equivalent to a finding that the practice of medicine by CHRISTOPHER JENSEN, M.D. (the Respondent) in that jurisdiction constitutes an imminent danger to the health of its people, as is more fully set forth in the "Board Ordered Summary Suspension" (henceforth: "predicate action"), attached hereto as Appendix "A" and made a part hereof.

It is therefore:

ORDERED, pursuant to N.Y. Public Health Law §230(12)(b), that effective immediately, Respondent shall not practice medicine in the State of New York, or practice in any setting under the authority of Respondent's New York license.

Any practice of medicine in violation of this Order shall constitute Professional Misconduct within the meaning of N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(29) and may constitute unauthorized medical practice, a Felony defined by N.Y. Educ. Law §6512.

This Order shall remain in effect until the final conclusion of a hearing which shall commence within thirty days after the final conclusion of the disciplinary proceeding in the predicate action. The hearing will be held pursuant to the provisions of N.Y. Pub.

Health Law §230, and N.Y. State Admin. Proc. Act §§301-307 and 401. The hearing will be conducted before a committee on professional conduct of the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct on a date and at a location to be set forth in a written Notice of Hearing or Notice of Referral Proceeding to be provided to the Respondent after the final conclusion of the proceeding in the predicate action. Said written Notice may be provided in person, by mail, or by other means. If Respondent wishes to be provided said written notice at an address other than that set forth above, Respondent shall so notify, in writing, both the attorney whose name is set forth in this Order, and the Director of the Office of Professional Medical Conduct, at the addresses set forth below.

Respondent shall notify the Director of the Office of Professional Medical Conduct, New York State Department of Health, Riverview Center, 150 Broadway, Suite 355, Albany, New York 12204-2719 via Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, of the final conclusion of the proceeding in the predicate action, immediately upon such conclusion.

THE NEW YORK PROCEEDINGS MAY RESULT IN A DETERMINATION THAT YOUR LICENSE TO PRACTICE MEDICINE IN NEW YORK STATE BE REVOKED OR SUSPENDED, AND/OR THAT YOU BE FINED OR SUBJECT TO OTHER SANCTIONS SET FORTH IN NEW YORK PUBLIC HEALTH LAW §230-a. YOU ARE URGED TO OBTAIN AN ATTORNEY TO REPRESENT YOU IN THIS MATTER.

BOARD ORDERED SUMMARY SUSPENSION

Upon the petition of the State of Alaska, Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing (Division") for Summary Suspension of Physician License, and upon the evidence presented by the Division, the Alaska State Medical Board ("Board") finds that Dr. Christopher J. Jensen, M.D., poses a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if he continues to practice medicine. The Board hereby orders, pursuant to AS 08.64.331(c), the summary suspension of Christopher Jensen's physician license in Alaska, number MEDS6676.

In accordance with AS 08.64.338, for the purposes of the Division's investigation in these matters, the Board orders Jensen to submit to psychiatric / psychological and medical evaluations, including the submission of biological specimens as deemed appropriate, to determine his ability to practice medicine in a manner consistent with public safety in Alaska. The evaluations shall be conducted by physicians or other practitioners designated by the Board's agent, at a time, date, and location to be determined by the Division, and must be completed within sixty days from the effective date of this Order. The Division shall provide the practitioner(s) conducting the evaluations with materials from the investigative files in this matter as deemed appropriate by the Division.

It is further ordered that, Dr. Jensen's license to practice medicine in Alaska will remain suspended, until such time as Dr. Jensen can demonstrate to the Board that he is fit to practice in a manner consistent with public safety.
