STATEMENT
OF
CHARGES

AARON WEINREB, M.D., was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on or about November 6, 2001, by the issuance of license number 223219 by the New York State Education Department.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

A. On or about July 13, 2021, in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted of one count of coercion & enticement to engage in criminal sexual activity (18 USC §2422(a)). The Respondent was sentenced to fifty-four months imprisonment, ordered to pay a fine of \$30,000.00. Upon release, the Respondent is to be on supervised release/probation for a term of ten years and required to register as a sex offender.

SPECIFICATION OF CHARGES

BEING CONVICTED OF COMMITTING AN ACT CONSTITUING A CRIME

Respondent is charged with committing professional misconduct as defined in N.Y. Educ. Law § 6530(9)(a)(ii) Being convicted of committing an act constituting a crime under federal law as alleged in the facts of the following:
