FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- A. On or about May 28, 2019, in the Nassau County Court in Nassau County, New York, Respondent pled guilty to, and was convicted of, third degree assault, a class A misdemeanor, under New York Penal Law § 120.00. On or about September 10, 2019, he was sentenced to three years of probation; an order of protection for five years; and fees and surcharges in the amount of \$250.
