CHARGES

FRANK SMITH, JR., P.A., the Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on or about July 19, 2011, by the issuance of license number 014903 by the New York State Education Department.

**FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS**

A. On or about June 9, 2022, in the County Court of the State of New York, Nassau County, Respondent was convicted of one count of Endangering the Welfare of a Child [New York Penal Law Section 260.10], a Class A misdemeanor. On or about January 27, 2023, Respondent was sentenced to three years' probation, was issued an Order of Protection for five years, and assessed fees and surcharges totaling \$250.00.
