STATEMENT
OF
CHARGES

YOUSIF ABDULRAOUF ALHALLAQ, M.D., the Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on or about July 20, 2012, by the issuance of license number 265982 by the New York State Education Department.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- A. On or about September 20, 2021, in the Court of Common Pleas for Stark County, Ohio, Respondent was deemed convicted, pursuant to a guilty plea, of one count of attempt to commit an offense (Murder) in violation of Ohio Revised Code sections 2923.02 and 2903.02(A) and of two counts of felonious assault in violation of Ohio Revised Code section 2903.11(A)(1), all felonies. Respondent was sentenced to incarceration for a period of four years, to a mandatory period of five years of post-release control on the first count, and of three years post-release control on the third count, and was required to pay a fine in the amount of \$10,000. The conviction arose from Respondent's effort to unlawfully end a pregnancy in or about 2014, without the woman's knowledge.
- B. The conviction for one of the counts of felonious assault (Count 2) was for a crime which, had it been committed in New York, would have been a crime pursuant to §§120.10 (first degree assault), 120.05 (second degree assault), and/or 120.00 (third degree assault) of the Penal Law.

CRIMINAL CONVICTION (Other Jurisdiction)

Respondent is charged with committing professional misconduct as defined in N.Y. Educ. Law § 6530(9)(a)(iii) by having been convicted of committing an act constituting a crime under the law of another jurisdiction and which, if committed within this state, would have constituted a crime under New York state law (namely N.Y. Penal Law §§120.10, 120.05, and/or 120.00) as alleged in the facts of the following:
