STATEMENT
OF
CHARGES

ANDREW DOWD, M.D., the Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on or about January 28, 1985, by the issuance of license number 161299 by the New York State Education Department.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

A. On or about April 25, 2023, in the United States District Court, Southern District of New York, Respondent was convicted of two felony counts of Conspiracy to Commit Mail and Wire Fraud [18 U.S.C. § 1349], two felony counts of Mail Fraud [18 U.S.C. 1341], and two felony counts of Wire Fraud [18 U.S.C. § 1343]. Respondent was sentenced to a total 102 months' imprisonment followed by a three-year period of supervised release and assessed \$600.00.

SPECIFICATION OF CHARGES

FIRST SPECIFICATION

Respondent violated Education Law § 6530(9)(a)(ii) by having been convicted of an act constituting a crime under federal law, in that Petitioner charges:
