IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the Petitioner and Respondent, that the within proceeding is hereby settled on the following terms and conditions:

1. Respondent's Determination and Order BPMC No. 03-96, dated April 18, 2003, is hereby modified solely to the extent of reducing the civil penalty imposed on Petitioner to the sum of $\$ 30,000$.
2. Paragraph Four (4) of the Order, at Page 50, is hereby restated as follows:
3. A civil penalty of Thirty Thousand Dollars shall be imposed and due in the following installments:
a. \$2,500 upon execution of this Stipulation
b. $\$ 2,500$ on or before November 3, 2003, and a like amount on the first day of every month thereafter until the balance is paid in full.
