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IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the
Petitioner and Respondent, that the within proceeding is hereby settled on
the following terms and conditions:

1. Respondent's Determination and Order BPMC No. 03-96, dated
April 18, 2003, is hereby modified solely to the extent of reducing the civil
penalty imposed on Petitioner to the sum of \$30,000.
2. Paragraph Four (4) of the Order, at Page 50, is hereby restated
as follows:

4. A civil penalty of Thirty Thousand Dollars shall be imposed and due in the following installments:

a. \$2,500 upon execution of this Stipulation

b. \$2,500 on or before November 3, 2003, and a like amount on the first day of every month thereafter until the balance is paid in full. Failure to make any installment when due will result in the entire balance of said penalty becoming immediately due and owing without further notice or demand.

3. Except as herein modified, all other terms, provisions and conditions of the order shall remain in full force and effect.

4. Simultaneously with the execution of this Stipulation, the Petitioner shall deliver to Respondent a stipulation discontinuing the within proceeding, with prejudice and without costs.
