That on or about September 6, 1973, I was licensed to

practice as a physician in the State of New York, having been issued License No. 117755 by the New York State Education

Department.

I am currently registered with the New York State Education Department to practice as a physician in the State of New York for the period January 1, 1991 through December 31, 1992 with a current registration address of 720 Riverview Road, Rexford, New York 12148.

I understand that the New York State Board of Professional Medical Conduct has charged me with two specifications of professional misconduct.

A copy of the Statement of Charges is annexed hereto, made a part hereof, and marked as Exhibit "A".

I admit guilt to the First Specification as it applies to Paragraphs A and A.1 of the Factual Allegations and all of the facts alleged therein, in full satisfaction of the charges against me.

I hereby agree to the penalty that I be censured and reprimanded.

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I hereby make this Application to the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct (the Board) and request that it be granted.

I understand that, in the event that this Application is not granted by the Board, nothing contained herein shall be binding upon me or construed to be an admission of any act of misconduct alleged or charged against me, such Application shall not be used against me in any way and shall be kept in strict confidence during the pendency of the professional misconduct disciplinary proceeding; and such denial by the Board shall be made without prejudice to the continuance of any disciplinary proceeding and the final determination by the Board pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Law.

I agree that, in the event the Board grants my Application, as set forth herein, an order of the Chairperson of the Board shall be issued in accordance with same.

I am making this Application of my own free will and accord and not under duress, compulsion or restraint of any kind or manner.

PRATIMA PATEL, M.D. : CHARGES

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PRATIMA PATEL, M.D., the Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on September 6, 1973 by the issuance of license number 117755 by the New York State Education Department. The Respondent is currently registered with the New York State Education Department to practice medicine for the period January 1, 1991 through December 31, 1992 with a current registration address of 720 Riverview Road, Rexford, New York 12148.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

A. Respondent, at various times, during a period extending from approximately August 26, 1991 through approximately mid-September 1991, at her office at 331 Usher Road, Ballston Lake, New York 12019, employed Barbara Wahl as a nurse. Ms. Wahl's duties included administering injections, drawing blood, doing throat cultures, obtaining urine samples and testing them,

recording height and weight and indicating patient symptoms in the respective patient's medical chart.

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 Respondent employed Ms. Wahl as a nurse even though she was unlicensed to practice as a nurse in New York State during the above period.

FIRST SPECIFICATION

Respondent is charged with permitting, aiding or abetting an unlicensed person to perform activities requiring a license, under N.Y. Educ. Law Sec. 6530 (11) (McKinney's Supp. 1992), in that:

1. The Petitioner charges the facts in Paragraph A and A.1.

SECOND SPECIFICATION

Respondent is charged with delegating professional responsibilities to a person whom she knew or had reason to know was not qualified by licensure to perform them, under N.Y. Educ. Law Sec. 6530 (25) (McKinney's Supp. 1992), in that:
