SAYEGH, to practice as a physician in the State of New York, was surrendered by Order of the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct dated November 6, 1997, and he having petitioned the Board of Regents for restoration of said license, and the Regents having given consideration to said petition and having reviewed the record, including his response to the draft report of the Committee on the Professions, and having disagreed with and rejected the recommendation of the Peer Committee, and having agreed with and adopted the recommendation of the Committee on the Professions for the reasons set forth in the Committee's Report, especially but not limited to his multiple relapses despite extensive treatment for drug dependency, and risk to the public that could arise should he practice while under the influence of drugs, and the failure to make a compelling case for restoration until he remains rehabilitated on a long-term basis, now, pursuant to action taken by the Board of Regents on March 17, 2015, it is hereby

ORDERED that the petition for restoration of License No. 173788, authorizing ABRAHAM J. SAYEGH to practice as a physician in the State of New York, is denied.
