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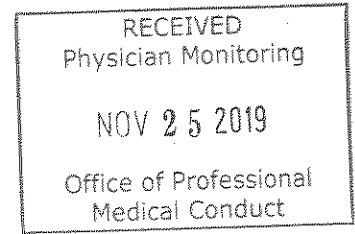

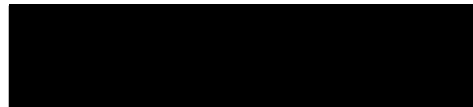

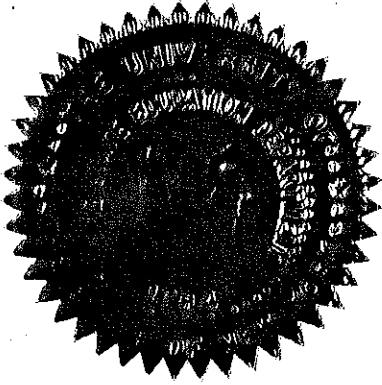

It appearing that the license of ABRAHAM SOLOMON, to practice as a physician in the State of New York, was revoked by Order of the Administrative Review Board for Professional Medical Conduct dated September 24, 2001. Mr. Solomon having first petitioned the Board of Regents for restoration of said license, which was denied on January 12, 2010, and he having petitioned the Board of Regents for restoration of said license for a second time on November 6, 2017, and the Board of Regents having given consideration to said petition and having reviewed the record, including his response to the draft report of the Committee on the Professions, and having agreed with and adopted the recommendations of the Peer Committee and the Committee on the Professions as set forth in the Committees' reports, now, pursuant to action taken by the Board of Regents on November 5, 2019, it is hereby

ORDERED that the petition for restoration of License No. 205496, authorizing ABRAHAM SOLOMON to practice as a physician in the State of New York, is denied.
