That on or about March 11. 1983, I was licensed to practice as a physician in the State of New York, having been issued.

License No. 153565 by the New York State Education Department.

I am currently registered with the New York State Education Department to practice as a physician in the State of New York for the period January 1, 1991 through December 31, 1992. My registered address is RD 7, 18 Spruce Park, Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania 18360.

I understand that the New York State Board of Professional Medical Conduct has charged me with Two Specifications of professional misconduct.

A copy of the Statement of Charges is annexed hereto, made a part hereof, and marked as Exhibit "A".

I admit guilt to the charged specifications and agree to the following penalty: a one year suspension of my license to practice medicine in New York State, with the entire suspension stayed conditioned on my full compliance with all Terms of Probation set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto, during a probationary period of one year.

I hereby make this Application to the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct (the Board) and request that it be granted.

I understand that, in the event that this Application is not granted by the Board, nothing contained herein shall be binding upon me or construed to be an admission of any act of misconduct alleged or charged against me, such Application shall not be used against me in any way and shall be kept in strict confidence during the pendency of the professional misconduct disciplinary proceeding; and such denial by the Board shall be made without prejudice to the continuance of any disciplinary proceeding and the final determination by the Board pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Law.

I agree that, in the event the Board grants my Application, as set forth herein, an order of the Chairperson of the Board shall be issued in accordance with same.

I am making this Application of my own free will and accord and not under duress, compulsion or restraint of any kind or manner.

ROBERT C. WALLEN, M.D., the Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on March 11, 1983, by the issuance of license number 153565 by the New York State Education Department. The Respondent is currently registered with the New York State Education Department to practice medicine for the period January 1, 1991, to December 31, 1992. Respondent's registered address with the New York State Education Department is RD 7, 18 Spruce Park, Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania 18360.

## FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

A. By Order dated May 28, 1991, the State Board of Medicine of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania concluded that Respondent was guilty of unprofessional conduct in violation of 63 P.S. §422.41(8) and 49 Pa. Code §16.61(a)(16) by making obscene phone calls to a former patient.

#### FIRST SPECIFICATION

Respondent is charged with professional misconduct under New York Education Law §6530(9)(b) (McKinney Supp. 1992) in that he has been found guilty of improper professional practice or professional misconduct by a duly authorized professional disciplinary agency of another state where the conduct upon which the finding was based would, if committed in New York State, constitute professional misconduct under the laws of New York State, in that Petitioner charges:

## SECOND SPECIFICATION

Respondent is charged with professional misconduct under New York Education Law §6530(9)(d) (McKinney Supp. 1992) in that disciplinary action was taken against Respondent after disciplinary action was instituted by a duly authorized professional disciplinary agency of another state, where the conduct resulting in the disciplinary action involving the license would, if committed in New York State, constitute professional misconduct under the law of New York State, in that Petitioner charges:

# EXHIBIT "B"

#### TERMS OF PROBATION

- 1. Robert C. Wallen, the Respondent, shall fully comply with all terms of the order dated May 28, 1991, of the State Board of Medicine of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- Respondent shall, during the period of probation, conduct himself in all ways in a manner befitting his professional status, and shall conform fully to the moral and professional standards of conduct imposed by law and by his profession;
- 3. That Respondent shall submit written notification to the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH), addressed to the Director, Office of Professional Medical Conduct, New York State Health Department, Corning Tower Building, 4th Floor, Empire State Plaza Albany, New York 12237 of the address and telephone number of his employment and practice, of Respondent's residence address and telephone number, of any change in Respondent's employment, practice, residence, or telephone number within or without the State of New York;
- 4. Respondent shall submit written proof from the Division of Professional Licensing Services (DPLS), New York State Education Department (NYSED), that Respondent has paid all registration fees due and owing to the NYSED and Respondent shall cooperate with and submit whatever papers are requested by DPLS in regard to said registration fees, said proof from DPLS to be submitted by Respondent to the New York State Department of Health, addressed to the Director, Office of Professional Medical Conduct, as aforesaid, no later than the first three months of the period of probation;
- 5. Respondent shall submit written proof to the NYSDOH, addressed to the Director, Office of Professional Medical Conduct, as aforesaid, that 1) Respondent is currently registered with the NYSED, unless Respondent submits written proof that Respondent has advised DPLS, NYSED, that Respondent is not engaging in the practice of Respondent's profession in the State of New York and does not desire to register, and that 2) Respondent has paid any fines which may have previously been imposed upon Respondent by the Board or by the Board of Regents; said proof of the above to be submitted no later than the first two months of the period of probation;

- 6. Respondent shall comply with all terms, conditions, restrictions, and penalties to which he is subject pursuant to the order of the Board;
- 7. So long as there is full compliance with every term herein set forth, Respondent may continue to practice his or her aforementioned profession in accordance with the terms of probation; provided, however, that upon receipt of evidence of noncompliance with, or any violation of these terms, the Director of the Office of Professional Medical Conduct and/or the Board may initiate a violation of probation proceeding and/or such other proceeding against Respondent as may be authorized pursuant to the Public Health Law.
