STATEMENT
OF
CHARGES

STEVEN BAUER, D.O., the Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on or about August 4, 1997 by the issuance of license number 207738 by the New York State Education Department.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- A. On or about December 10, 2015 Respondent was convicted of the misdemeanor Driving While Intoxicated-Level 5 in Mecklenburg County, North Carolina Superior Court. Respondent was sentenced to a suspended sentence of thirty days imprisonment, 12 months of unsupervised probation and assessed court costs of \$592.50.
- B. Respondent's crime as described above in North Carolina would, if committed in New York State, have constituted a crime under New York State law, specifically N.Y. Vehicle and Traffic Law §1192 (3) (Driving While Intoxicated, an unclassified misdemeanor).

SPECIFICATION OF CHARGES

CRIMINAL CONVICTION (Other Jurisdiction)

Respondent is charged with committing professional misconduct as defined in N.Y. Educ. Law § 6530(9)(a)(iii) by having been convicted of committing an act constituting a

crime under the law of another jurisdiction and which, if committed within this state, would have constituted a crime under New York state law (namely N.Y. Vehicle and Traffic Law § 1192 (3)) as alleged in the facts of the following:
